The Community Safety Partnership exists to build and maintain relationships across the Borough so that those involved in community safety in its widest sense can support each other in the shared pursuit of our goals.

For the period 2008-2011 in particular

Key Objectives

- To reduce death and injury caused through road collisions and fires
- To create, build, maintain and improve links between agencies in order to target vulnerable adult referrals to Essex County Fire & Rescue Service (ECFRS), in particular from adult social care
- To become more ambitious with road and rail safety education and prevention campaigns aimed at schools and parents
- To reduce road traffic collisions through education and prevention campaigns aimed at 17-25 year olds
- To continue with young people at risk through ECFRS fire education programmes and youth schemes.
- To develop and adapt existing road and rail safety programmes to target young people displaying risk taking behaviour
- To work with the development corporation and highways to reduce risk through design and prevention
- To link into British Transport Police and Network Rail to address safety on the railways
